"In the **Large Motor Center**, I can run around, jump rope, kick a ball, hop on one foot, and swing a bat. Playing games teaches me to take turns, be a good sport, and let others try to follow my lead. I am getting bigger and stronger and ready for school. I can hardly wait to climb the school bus steps by myself!"



"**Dramatic Play** lets me try on the world. Yesterday I was a princess and today I am fighting fires. Tomorrow I might be an accountant like my dad. When I pretend to be someone else, I get to practice my grown-up manners, answer the telephone, drive a car, explore the future, and learn new words."



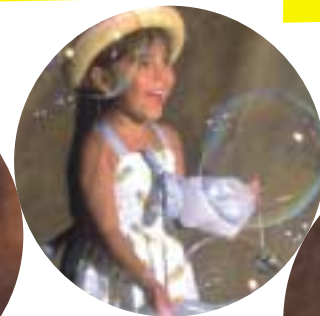
