North Pole Patent #100,000,001 Family-Built Front Yard Snowman

As seen in Fig. 1, the snowman is comprised primarily of snow packed into three large spheres, with height inversely proportional to size. At points in the center front of the middle sphere are three buttons (1) from your family's junk drawer. Perpendicular to the button line and angled upward are two arms (2) comprised of sticks. The ligature (3) between the middle and smallest spheres is a scarf. On the smallest sphere are advantageously placed adornments implying facial features, in particular the nose (4) and above that two round objects, stones or coal blocks, for eyes (5). It will be apparent that various changes and modifications can be made to facial features without deviating from the scope of the overall design. Additionally, the hat (6) can be replaced with a cap or left off.

The embodiments of the snowman in which an exclusive property or privilege is claimed are defined as follows:

1. A holiday season article comprising:
a family coming together;
a plurality of items found around the house and yard; and
a feeling of warmth.
2. The holiday season article of claim 1, further comprising:
a happiness one receives when their honey remembers to pick up extra carrots for the snowman's nose.
3. The holiday season article of claim 1, wherein your family experiences its own unique holiday cheer!
